## **Bicentennial Art Tour Call for Entry**

April, 2011

**Purpose:** To celebrate Brecksville's Bicentennial, increase awareness and opportunities of local artists and Brecksville Center for the Arts programming.

**Requirements:** All work must be, in some part, made by the artist. Each artist must reside in Brecksville or Broadview Heights or the work created as a part of Brecksville Center for the Arts programming.

### **Some Ideas for Items from past shows include:**

• Matted or framed art in any medium • Baskets • Ceramic work • Mosaic pieces • Small stained glass pieces • Jewelry • Wreaths and swags and Sculpture.

### **How the Event works:**

1. During the entire month of April, 2011, artwork will be displayed at several locations throughout Brecksville. People will be able to view your work based on open hours of the venue where it is displayed. A list of venues will be published in a "Tour Book" that will be available throughout the City.

2. Artists interested in participating must submit their call for entry and release form to Brecksville Center for the Arts on or before March 1. Art will be reviewed and accepted based on space availability. Location will be assigned along with hanging date and tear down date. Items may be for display or for sale. Items in BCA locations are subject to a 30% gallery fee and BCA will handle the location. Items at other locations should be handled by the artist unless otherwise agreed.

3. A reception for all artists will be held on Friday evening, April 29<sup>th</sup> to celebrate. A drawing for prizes will be held that evening for those who view all locations and have their Tour Book validated at each location.

3. A release form must be signed and returned to the BCA office.

4. Artist Bios or Statements should be submitted to the BCA office to be posted on website, used for press released and information for the Tour Book.

5. Artists should limit their work to one or two pieces. If additional works are needed, we will contact artists for more submissions.

6. Checks payable to the artist will be mailed one week following the show for works sold by BCA.

7. Artists will be responsible for display of their work at assigned location.
