

Material List

“Truly Beginner Watercolor Class” with Deanna Clucas

Paint: Transparent watercolor tubes. Winsor & Newton can be found in most arts and craft stores; Pat Catan's, Michael's, JoAnn's

Colors: Alizarin Crimson
Cadmium Red Light
Cadmium Yellow Light
Yellow Ochre
Ultramarine Blue
Cerulean Blue
Burnt Sienna
Vandyke Brown

Palette: Large covered plastic palette or large enameled butcher tray.

Brushes: Flats 1/2", 1"
Rounds #6, #10 or #12
Rigger or Striper #2

These can be synthetic or synthetic/natural blends, but be sure they are watercolor brushes. A clerk can help you pick them out.

Paper: 140# Cold Pressed pad or 12-15 sheets 11" x 15" or 2-3 sheets of 22" x 30" that can be divided in quarters.

Board to hold paper while painting: 16" x 20" strong cardboard or foam board.

Water Container can be empty margarine tubs.

Pencils: #2 soft

Kneaded Eraser

Masking tape 3/4"

Bag to hold it all
