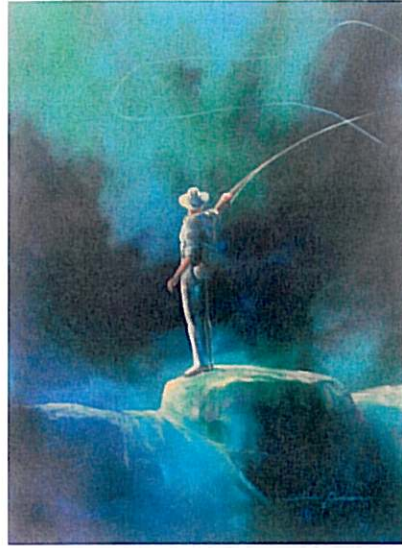
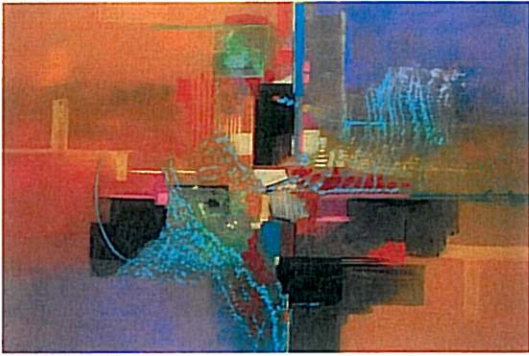


Sandra Dennison
